**4. NEW BUSINESS**

- a. Eagle Scout Brady Bolley with Troup 231 presented to the Park and Rec Board his idea for a paddle and ball holder for the pickleball court. It will have a lid and be weather proofed. His initial thought was on the outside of the fence. Joe offered to work with him so they can do a locate together so they don't hit any utilities.

- j. Community / Park Tree Management: Council accepted Boyum.
- k. Budget: Edging at Riverside Park.
